

WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER PROPOSAL

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, WHITELEY) (PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2004 (VARIATION NO.4) ORDER 2020

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make the above road traffic regulation order. The proposed Order is required to prevent obstruction, to maintain the free-flow of traffic and to improve visibility and road safety.

The effect of this Order will be to:

- Introduce lengths of no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on Bluebell Way, Whiteley and on Silver Birch Way at its junction with Bluebell Way.
- Amend The Hampshire (Various Roads, Whiteley) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2004 to bring it in line with restrictions on street in Leafy Lane and Parkway.
