

Statement of Reasons

The Winchester City Council (Various Roads, Wickham) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2009 (Variation No.2) Order 2020.

The formalisation of the existing 'no stopping on school entrance' markings were requested by the school, and supported by local councillors, to improve safety and pedestrian sight lines on access and egress from the school.

The replacement of formalised disabled bays with no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) is proposed on Buddens Road as residents of adjacent properties are no longer eligible for them. Additionally the bays are positioned on a bend, close to the school entrance, removing the parked vehicles improves driver and pedestrian visibility.

The replacement of formalised disabled bays with no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) is proposed on Station Road as the bays are on the approach to the junction with Mill Lane, forcing drivers onto the wrong side of the road close to the junction. The doctor's surgery that was located here when the bays were installed has been replaced with private residences with off street parking.

Due consideration has been given to Sections 122(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
