THE WINCHESTER CITY (BARFIELD CLOSE AND ST CATHERINE'S VIEW) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2003 (VARIATION NO.5) ORDER 2021

Winchester City Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 32, 35, 122 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling and amending legislation and powers, with consent of Hampshire County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:-

1. In this order the "Principal Order" means "The Winchester City (Barfield Close and St Catherine's View) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2003 (as amended)."
2. The Principal Order shall have effect in that the items specified in Schedule I of this Order shall be inserted into The Schedule of the Principal Order.
3. This order may be cited as "The Winchester City (Barfield Close and St Catherine's View) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2003 (Variation No.5) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on the 1st of March 2022.
