Introduction

Winchester City Council is proposing to develop a small number of council homes on land owned by the council -

- All of the new homes would be owned and managed by the council
- It is intended that the homes would be for rent
- The properties would be available to people with a recognised local connection to Sparsholt

Aims

- To update residents on the scheme proposals prior to a planning application
- To provide information on the energy efficiency standard of the homes
- To encourage local people in housing need to register with Hampshire Home Choice

Why is Winchester City Council considering developing new homes at Woodman Close?

- There is a serious shortage of affordable homes in the district with demand hugely outstripping supply
- There is an identified need within Sparsholt Parish for new affordable homes
- The land identified can accommodate a small number of council homes to meet local needs
- The council is able to make significant savings by building new council homes for rent on land that it owns, ensuring value for money and that rents can be kept as low as possible


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

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

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


